

Once you have finished cutting you can push out all the roof semi-circles and flower petals slightly towards the 'best' side. Next fold all score lines inwards on the house and the bird perch, EXCEPT the roofline and the scorelines where the very bottom of the roof panels meet the walls as these create the 'eaves'. Next flip the house over and add glue to the 'best' side of the three flaps indicated on the house and bird perch. The flaps on the apexes which go under the roof do not need to be glued, they are there to ensure everything tucks away neatly. You can then stick the house together. For the perch you need to fold round the glued flap and stick to the panel nearest the bird so the perch is a triangular prism shape (much easier to make than a cylinder!) You then poke the perch into the small hole at the front of the house - it will be snug so might need a bit of careful persuasion. Push the perch to the back of the inside of the house. You can then place the house over a battery tea light - you'll need to move the tealight to slightly one side so the 'flame' doesn't touch the perch. Do NOT place the lantern anywhere near a real tealight or naked flame!
